DOWNTOWN VENUE



The vision for a second venue came during the Winter Prayer and Fasting Week of 2017, and was confirmed in Pastor Jon's heart in the fall. The vision was announced in November 2018. After much prayer, planning and an agreement to use Knox Presbyterian Church's sanctuary in Downtown Lloydminster, we held two worship nights in early February. We launched MOSAIC's downtown venue on February 25, 2018. Attendance has been consistently growing at our Downtown Campus while our Lakeland Campus keeps flourishing. These are just the first two of the many Mosaic venues to be born in Jesus' name.
