Our heart as a church is not to presume on the past work for our future work at Mosaic. We want to raise the sails and catch the wind of the Holy Spirit as we prepare for the mission ahead!

Here are some action steps
that might help you get going each day.

Pause & Reflect - Find a way to pause whatever is happening so you can spend the next few minutes focused on the day's prayer focus. This might mean you change the station or turn off the music. It might mean stepping into a quiet room or going for a walk outside. Whatever it takes for you to pause the busy life around you, go for it. Take a deep breath and pause.

Read - Sometimes when we don't have a clue what to say to God, it helps to have a Scripture to prompt our words. Each day we have provided a verse and a small thought for you to pray. Take a moment to read them, and then put them in your own words when you pray.

Speak - Finally, when you're ready, speak your prayer out loud. There is power when we move beyond the thoughts in our heads and use our mouths for the glory of the Lord. This might be uncomfortable at first, but the more we speak out loud, it just becomes our new norm for prayer.

Remember what we said at the start—prayer is just talking to God and He loves to hear His children speak.

DAY 1

Prayer Moves the Kingdom of Christ Forward

Pause & Reflect:

The question we want to start with today is: what place does prayer have in your life as you start this journey? Is it a meal-time ritual or does it only happen when you need God most? Wherever you are in your prayer journey, there is an example we can follow to grow our prayer life. His name is Jesus. He believed prayer moved the Kingdom of God forward, and lived out His prayer life with that urgency. As we go through this journey, we will follow His example as recorded in John 17, which is Jesus' prayer during His final moments before the cross.

For the next 21 days, we want to get bold with our prayers. We want to see God move His Kingdom forward through our church. The hour has come; will you join us in prayer for this journey? On a journal, write down areas in your life where you want to see God's miraculous movement.

Read Hebrews 5:7

"While Jesus was here on earth, he offered prayers and pleadings, with a loud cry and tears, to the one who could rescue him from death. And God heard his prayers because of his deep reverence for God." (NLT)

Speak a prayer that God would transform your prayer life over the next 21 days to look more like Jesus' — with desperation and honesty.

DAY 2

God Saved Us!

Pause & Reflect: God saw our mess and our problems, and He brought rescue to our lives through Jesus Christ. Then, if that wasn't enough, Jesus empowers transformation in us by giving us the guidance of the Holy Spirit - God's very Presence - to live in us. Jesus started His prayer by saying thank you to God, and that is where we want to start today.

Read John 17:1

"After saying all these things, Jesus looked up to heaven and said, 'Father, the hour has come. Glorify your Son so he can give glory back to you.'" (NLT)

Speak a prayer of thanksgiving today to God for sending Jesus to save us, and for allowing the same Spirit to live in you every day.

Prayer Items:

1. That the Holy Spirit will continue to fill our pastors and leaders at Mosaic Church.
2. That more people will come to faith in Jesus and become a part of our church community as growing, Spirit-filled disciples.
3. That you will be obedient to the Holy Spirit when He prompts you to invite someone to church; pray for someone in struggling; or give to someone in need.
4. That you will be consistent in the 21 day prayer journey.

DAY 3

The storms of life

Pause & Reflect: Jesus astounded His disciples in Mark 4 when they were caught in a massive storm and feared they will die. Jesus showed His power that evening in a way that the disciples have never seen before. Sometimes, we find ourselves in the middle of a storm, but sometimes we find the storm inside of us. Do you believe that Jesus can calm the storm around you or even the one inside you.

Read Mark 4:35-41

35 That day when evening came, he said to his disciples, "Let us go over to the other side." 36 Leaving the crowd behind, they took him along, just as he was, in the boat. There were also other boats with him. 37 A furious squall came up, and the waves broke over the boat, so that it was nearly swamped. 38 Jesus was in the stern, sleeping on a cushion. The disciples woke him and said to him, "Teacher, don't you care if we drown?" 39 He got up, rebuked the wind and said to the waves, "Quiet! Be still!" Then the wind died down and it was completely calm. 40 He said to his disciples, "Why are you so afraid? Do you still have no faith?" 41 They were terrified and asked each other, "Who is this? Even the wind and the waves obey him!"

Speak an honest prayer today that acknowledges the storms around you and inside you. Don't deny the storm you're in. Ask Jesus, the only one who could calm your storms to move in your life.

Prayer Items:

1. That Christ would calm the storm you're in, or the one that's inside you.
2. Bring all your personal cares and worries to Him.

DAY 4

One Authority Given by One God

Pause & Reflect: We live in a time where there are so many views on things eternal. As a church, the only eternal authority we can stand on is one true God. He is the Creator of the universe, the Mighty One, the King of Kings, and the Father. Jesus was the radiance of God's Glory, the exact representation of His being (Hebrews 1:3). Jesus was sent by the one true God and is empowered by His authority. Our church is led by that authority in Jesus through the shepherds He has placed over us, and our confidence completely rests in the authority of Jesus and His Word.

Read John 17:2-3

"For you have given him authority over everyone. He gives eternal life to each one you have given him. And this is the way to have eternal life—to know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, the one you sent to earth." (NLT)

Speak a prayer for our church today that we will continue to keep growing in quality and in quantity. Pray that we will stay strong in every way in the coming year and that we will stand only on the the authority of Jesus as given by the one true God.

Prayer Items:

1. That we will see new DG leaders, Dream Team Volunteers and generous givers raised at Mosaic.
2. For revival among young people (teens and young adults) of our city. Pray that they will come to Christ and be disciplined in the church.
3. Pray for yourself, that you will find ways to participate in the growth of the Kingdom of God.

DAY 5

Always at Work!

Pause & Reflect: God never stops working. As one of our favorite worship song goes:

Even when we don't see it, You're working

Even when we don't feel it, You're working.

When caught in the storm, the disciples wondered if Jesus even cared. What areas in your personal life does God seem to be quiet? What do you think is He teaching you in those areas? Trust that even though He seems quiet, He is working. Before proceeding to read, take a piece of paper and write down concerns and areas where you think God's is quiet in.

Read Mark 4:38-39

38 Jesus was in the stern, sleeping on a cushion.

The disciples woke him and said to him, "Teacher, don't you care if we drown?" 39 He got up, rebuked the wind and said to the waves, "Quiet! Be still!"

Then the wind died down and it was completely calm.

Speak a prayer for of faith--enumerate the areas where you think God is quiet, and acknowledge that He is at work in the the background.

Prayer Items:

1. Pray through the personal prayer items you wrote down and acknowledge that God is at work even though you don't see or feel it.
2. Memorize John 5:17, "My Father is always working to this very day, and I too am working."

DAY 6

Shining our Light

Pause & Reflect: Have you ever been fascinated by stars? The Bible says, every star testifies to the power of the One who made each of them. Psalm 19 tells us that the moon and stars all speak of God's power and glory. The church and every single believer is described as a city on a hill with a light that cannot be hidden (Matthew 5:14). We are designed to reveal the power and the goodness of God. We shine our light by loving others, sharing His loves, leading people to Jesus, inviting them to His family, the church. We reveal Jesus to a world that needs Him. Jesus prayed to reveal God to those around Him, and we want to do the same.

Read John 17:6

"I have revealed you to the ones you gave me from this world. They were always yours. You gave them to me, and they have kept your word." (NLT)

Speak a prayer for our church that we will be a shining light that reveals God to our city, and a prayer for yourself that you will be a light wherever you go, to point people to Jesus.

Prayer Items:

1. That the Holy Spirit will fill you so you may point someone to Jesus today.
2. Ask God to reveal to you a specific person who He wants you to pray for and point to Jesus.

DAY 7

Put People on Our Path

Pause & Reflect: Jesus walked everywhere while He was doing life on earth. Those walks took Him to markets, houses, fishing expeditions, and people. Jesus trusted God to put people on His path and God answered. God put fishermen, tax collectors, women no one else would speak to, lepers, and teachers of the law before Jesus. He met them and everything changed. Have you ever considered God has a desire to put people on our path who need the love of Jesus? What if a bold prayer today led you to look more like Jesus by looking for people on your path?

Read John 17:6

"I have revealed you to the ones you gave me from this world. They were always yours. You gave them to me, and they have kept your word." (NLT)

Speak a bold prayer for our church that God would put people into our path, stir us up to invest in their lives, and reveal Himself to them, so He can transform their lives with His love.

Action Points:

1. Find ways to regularly serve people who are in need.
2. Speak to someone about Jesus this week and invite them to join you to church.
3. Ask the Holy Spirit to help you be sensitive to the need of people around you and pray for them.

Led by His Word

Pause & Reflect: What is leading you right now? Maybe right now Waze, Siri or Google is speaking directions to your next destination. Maybe you're being led by the words of an instruction manual trying to assemble that baby crib the furniture store employee said would be easy to build. (We know it's not!) Some of you are being led by words from a friend as you try to cope with whatever trouble has come your way. There are lots of words leading our lives, both in the simple and important parts.

For Jesus, there was only one message and one place for His Word—God. We want to be a church that is obedient and led by God's Word. What role does God's Word have in leading you today?

Read John 17:8

"For I have passed on to them the message you gave me. They accepted it and know that I came from you, and they believe you sent me." (NLT)

Speak a prayer for our church and for yourself to accept, believe, and obey the Word of God.

Prayer Points:

1. Identify commands and challenges you struggle obeying.
2. Pray for a change of heart-- an listening, faithful and obedient heart.

DAY 9

What are you afraid of?

Pause & Reflect: What are you afraid of? Most children (even some adults) are still afraid of the dark. The fear of the dark results from a deeper fear, fear of the unknown. We feel the dark poses threats we don't see, which makes us cower in fear. However, sometimes our fear comes from what we see in front of us. A huge debt, a medical report, something that is beyond our control. The disciples, in Mark 4, saw a storm which posed multiple threats, including the possibility of death. What are you afraid of? Is it something you don't see? Is it something in front of you? We tend to fear that which we cannot control. The disciples knew they had no control over the wind and the waves that threaten the integrity of the boat and their own lives. If you are overwhelmed by anxiety and fear, worries and cares, remember the promise of Jesus, you can cast them all on Him because He cares for you.

Read Mark 4:40

He said to his disciples, "Why are you so afraid? Do you still have no faith?"

Speak a prayer today getting personal with God and cast all the things you fear about to Him. Name each of these fears and surrender them to Jesus.

Prayer Items:

1. Give up your fears and anxieties on God.
2. Acknowledge His favor and provision for all your needs.

DAY 10

Protect Us from the Enemy

Pause & Reflect: Did you know there is an unseen battle going on right now? A battle that has two clear sides—good versus evil. Jesus spoke a little about this unseen battle when said the thief comes to kill steal and destroy, but He came to give you life to the full (John 10:10). God battles on our behalf with a full legion at His command. Every day we can wage war with God by praying against that enemy and his thievery ways. Take a look around—what is the thief taking that needs to be stopped? What would today look like if you considered your prayer as a battle cry for yourself or others?

Read John 17:11

"Now I am departing from the world; they are staying in this world, but I am coming to you. Holy Father, you have given me your name; now protect them by the power of your name so that they will be united just as we are." (NLT)

Speak a prayer boldly today for God to protect us all—especially the pastors—from the traps of the enemy, by the power of His Holy Spirit.

Experiencing Full Joy

Pause & Reflect: Did you know that Jesus prayed for you to experience full joy today? Joy is so much stronger than a temporal happiness we seek so often. Galatians 5:22 lets us know that unlike happiness, joy comes as fruit or work of the Holy Spirit in us. Joy is a sustained triumph and Godly perspective that is greater than any one high or low we have in life. Jesus had joy and wanted to share that with all who followed Him. Where do you need to experience joy? Do you believe it's possible even with your current circumstances?

Read John 17:13

"Now I am coming to you. I told them many things while I was with them in this world so they would be filled with my joy."

Speak a prayer boldly today for God to allow you to experience the full measure of joy Jesus prayed for in John 17. Don't hold back on any of the challenges or obstacles that seem to crowd out His joy from you.

Prayer Items:

1. Joy is one of the signs of revival. Ask God to restore to you the joy of His salvation (Psalm 16:11).
2. Joy keeps us from burnout. Ask God to keep fueling you with passion for His purpose.
3. Joy is generous. If you're not yet a tither, challenge yourself to tithe, and experience the joy of giving.

DAY 12

Responding to Hate with Love

Pause & Reflect: These days, there is a growing anti-christian, anti-church sentiment in North America, where the institutional church used to have influence and a voice no longer exist. Part of the reason for that is because people who claim to be Christians became more known for what they are against than what they are for. While we should stand firm on the Truth of God, we should also preach and live out the Grace of God. Not everyone will like that, but Jesus called this out in this prayer to let us know there will be strong opposition: the world will hate us. So what will be our response be when we experience hate? What would it look like to respond out of the love Jesus modeled for us?

Read John 17:14

"I have given them your word. And the world hates them because they do not belong to the world, just as I do not belong to the world." (NLT)

Speak a prayer for our church family that when the world opposes us or rejects the Gospel message, that we will respond by showing love and kindness.

The Prayer of St. Francis (AD 1199)

*Lord, make me an instrument of your peace:
where there is hatred, let me sow love;
where there is injury, let me sow pardon;
where there is doubt, let me sow faith;
where there is despair, let me sow hope;
where there is darkness, let me sow light;
where there is sadness, let me sow joy.*

DAY 13

Opposing the Evil One

Pause & Reflect: All evil has a leader. Every enemy has a general. Jesus got ultra-specific again about the forces at work against us in His prayer by calling out the "evil one." Jesus knew something we didn't: there is an agenda. Ephesians 6:12 says, *"For we are not fighting against flesh-and-blood enemies, but against evil rulers and authorities of the unseen world, against mighty powers in this dark world, and evil spirits in the heavenly places."* (NLT)
Today, would you consider the agenda of the leader of evil? As we enter a new season ready to go after our mission with the full force of the church, our leadership needs your prayers to keep them safe from his tactics and agendas.

Read John 17:15

"I'm not asking you to take them out of the world, but to keep them safe from the evil one." (NLT)

Speak a prayer boldly on behalf of our church's leadership that God would keep them safe from the evil one's agenda and tactics. Pray a prayer of protection over yourself and family against the lies, attacks and plans of the enemy.

Greater Than...

Pause & Reflect: When the disciples saw the power of Jesus over the forces of nature, the Bible says, they were terrified! They all wondered: "Who is this?" Another translation says, "What manner of man is He?" At this Jesus had not been with them for very long. They were blown away by Jesus power. One word and the storm they were all afraid of was gone. In case you forget, this is the same Jesus we worship and serve. He is the same Jesus who is our savior and Lord. He is the same Jesus who, with one word, can calm our storms and change our lives. He is greater than anyone or anything!

Read Mark 4:41

They were terrified and asked each other, "Who is this? Even the wind and the waves obey him!"

Speak a prayer of worship and praise. Take time to really praise Jesus today.

Acknowledge that Jesus is greater than:

1. Our worries and cares.
2. Our sin and our past.
3. The lies of the enemy.
4. The needs that we have.
5. The fears in our hearts.
6. The illness we face.
7. The storms we are in.

DAY 15

Set Apart

Pause & Reflect: We were not created to just blend in, but instead to be set apart. Jesus used the word "holy" in His prayer for us, and that word means to be set apart. To be set apart means, we belong to Him. We are His people, we are His children. We live for His glory and we fulfill His purpose for us. We're not meant to just be like everyone else. We follow the example of Jesus--in love and in service. Where are you blending in instead of allowing God to help you become holy and set apart?

Read John 17:17

"Make them holy by your truth; teach them your word, which is truth." (NLT)

Speak a prayer for God to make you holy or set apart for His purpose by His truth.

Prayer Items:

1. That we will all grow in our love and obedience to Jesus.
2. That God's love will be evident in all we do.

Church Concerns:

1. The Vic Juba Theatre has informed us that they are no longer able to accommodate us. While we are happy and have a great relationship with May Theatre, let us pray for God's miraculous provision and an open door for a more permanent home for our church.

2. A physical building would be a bonus blessing, but our real calling and blessing is to build up the Body of Christ--the people of God, which is the real church (1 Peter 2:5)!

DAY 16

Sent on a Mission

Pause & Reflect: It is easy to see that we have lots of people attending services every week, we often max out our seating capacity. Thanks to people who invite their friends, colleagues and family, we are seeing more and more people join us in worship. This leads to an even larger question that needs to be asked of us as a church:

What is our sending capacity? Let that sink in for a moment. How many of our people are leaving Sunday, heading into Monday with a mission to share Jesus and bring people to God? Jesus raised the bar on following Him through this prayer by reminding us that just as He was sent on a mission, so are we. What would it look like if everyone of us will embrace our mission calling people who are far from God?

What if our sending capacity matched our seating capacity?

Read John 17:18

"Just as you sent me into the world, I am sending them into the world." (NLT)

Speak a prayer that we would be more than just passive church attendee; that we would be sent into the world to show and share the love of Jesus.

Vision Prayer Items:

1. *Let's pray that our attendance double in size by December.* If each of us will reach out to one person and bring them within the next three months, we can see our worship attendance double in size, and have the opportunity to lead them to receive Christ, be baptized and be fully devoted followers of Jesus.
2. *Begin to pray for that person that God wants you to bring.* Take that challenge from Jesus to find and bring that one lost lamb back to God.

Covered by Jesus' Prayers

Pause & Reflect: Think about this—you have been covered in prayer by Jesus today. Jesus took time during prayer to think about all of those who one day would find and follow Him. Being supported in prayer by Jesus means our entire walk is held up by His powerful name. This challenges us in the same way to consider the many believers who are waking up today around the world to follow the message of Christ. Take a moment to consider all of the different situations believers might be waking up today. Some are struggling to believe, some are not able to be public with their faith, and others are showing up at a school desiring to be a light to their friends. Will you join the prayer of Jesus today by praying for all of our brothers and sisters who follow Him?

Read John 17:20

"I am praying not only for these disciples but also for all who will ever believe in me through their message." (NLT)

Speak a prayer today for all people who will follow Jesus, and begin to prophesy their growth, how they'll serve, how generous they'll be, how God will use them to build the Body of Christ.

Prayer Items:

1. Speak life and salvation for person that God wants you to invite. Believe that God is already working ahead of time.
2. Prophesy over their lives: their salvation, their baptism, how God will use them in His church (as a worship leaders, DG leader or member, a welcome team, etc.).

Speak and pray boldly in Jesus' name.

United as One Leadership

Pause & Reflect: Being united as one allows us the ability to move forward effectively. Even in the simple things—like your family trying to choose a place to eat, or coming around a huge group of fans who all support the same team—unity creates something special. When the importance of the work rises, so does the importance of being united as one. Jesus prayed that very prayer so that He and the Father would reflect that ideal. Now, I want you to consider the leadership of our church. God has appointed them to guide us through the Holy Spirit into a new season of ministry and mission. We need them to be one—not just with one another, but with Jesus and the Father—so we can catch the wind of the Holy Spirit.

Read John 17:21

"I pray that they will all be one, just as you and I are one—as you are in me, Father, and I am in you...." (NLT)

Speak a prayer today that God would empower us to be one, in all we do, just as Jesus and the Father are one.

Vision Prayer Items:

1. Pray for your Leadership Team: Pastor Jon (our Lead Pastor), Pastor Ta (our Associate Pastor), Richie Davies and Ambet David (our Trustees), that they will always be obedient to the Word and the leading of the Spirit.
2. Pray for a permanent home for Mosaic. Let us be united in this vision and desire to have a permanent ministry location for our church--a place where we can worship, hold discipleship, host activities, etc.
3. Pray that we will always stand behind the one mission and vision God has for us.

Pause & Reflect: Keeping with our unity thought from yesterday, we want to shift the conversation from leadership to the Church in Lloydminster. Today more than ever, we have to ask the question, what are Christians known for in our city? If we were to be gone tomorrow, would we be missed? Jesus described the church as a force of good when He said the gates of hell would not prevail against it (Matthew 16:18). We also know the church is one body made up of many parts (1 Corinthians 12:12-14). What a unique position the Church has today. We can come together with different backgrounds and skills and be people united by Jesus for a greater good. Today, our prayer matters for the whole Church (big C)—to be one in our desire lift up Jesus, so that our city would know Him and his love.

Read John 17:23

"I am in them and you are in me. May they experience such perfect unity that the world will know that you sent me and that you love them as much as you love me." (NLT)

Speak a prayer today that God will heal the hearts of individual local churches, that there will be no sense of competition, or animosity. Pray that Christians in Lloyd will bloom where God has planted them. May we be devoted fully to the church where God has planted us, and stop shuffling from one local church to another. May all believers embrace the mission of inviting and bring the not-yet-believers.

Prayer Items:

1. Remember to pray for and reach out to that person God wants you to bring before Christmas!
2. Pray for our desire to see our attendance and disciples to double in number by December.

Remember Who you're with

Pause & Reflect: There is something powerful about being in the presence of someone we feel is important.

Whoever you assign importance to in life, from a father to a famous person, being in their presence is an experience that leaves us different. As people who follow Jesus, we can be in the presence of someone of great importance daily: God Himself. Being with the God doesn't require our perfection, just our presence. It is there we can find comfort, security, identity, and so much more. In Mark 4, the disciples when in the middle of a powerful storm, but when they saw Jesus calm the storm, they realized they were in the presence of someone more powerful than the storm.

Will you recognize today how beyond bless you are to be in the presence of someone beyond powerful?

Read John 17:24

"Father, I want these whom you have given me to be with me where I am. Then they can see all the glory you gave me because you loved me even before the world began!" (NLT)

Speak a prayer today that the Father will let you see His glory and let you feel His presence!

Activity:

Just take time to bask in God's presence. Talk to Him as your Father and Friend! He hears your prayers. He will calm you soul. He give you peace.

Radical Revelers of His Love

Pause & Reflect: The journey of our church has been happening for more than 7 years. God has used us to impact Lloydminster, the surrounding area, and the world with the love of Jesus. We have been a church that partners with organization that are doing amazing things. We have been a church that has helped plant churches. We have launched some of our new leaders into Bible college and ministries. We have been a church that sends people on a missions abroad. We have responded to areas affected by calamities. We have seen people born again and baptized by the hundreds. As we get ready for the future, we want to be the same church that radically reveals God's love for people locally and beyond. But we are praying for greater faith, greater commitment, greater generosity, greater passion to reach people far from God be made alive and included in Christ.

On this last day of our 21 Days of Prayer, will you pray and make a covenant with the Lord that you will reveal God's love so that people who are far from God will be made alive and included in Christ?

Read John 17:26. *"I have revealed you to them, and I will continue to do so. Then your love for me will be in them, and I will be in them."*

Speak a prayer today that you as well as the whole church comprised of radical revealers of God's love to honor God, love people and make disciples.
