LOOKING BACK | MOVING FORWARD

ARUCH HASHEM. That is perhaps my favorite Hebrew phrase! It literally means, "Blessed be the Name." It is most commonly used as a response to compliment said (e.g. "You have a lovely voice!" "Aw! Thanks! Baruch Hashem!" The phrase comes straight from the Word of God.

Psalm 113:2 King James Version
Blessed be the name of the Lord
from this time forth and for evermore.

Looking back at what God has done in us, for us and through us, I cannot think of a more fitting response but shout, "Baruch Hashem."

Over these last ten years, we have seen the Lord move in mighty ways. Over 700 individuals have discovered the love of Christ for them and have put their faith in Him for their salvation. Over 200 people have followed Christ in baptism, many of them through discipleship and mentorship discovered their spiritual gifts, and are now serving in the church for God's glory. We have witnessed miracles of life change, healing, provision, deliverance, restoration of broken relationships, revival, and many more-- for which we shout, 'Blessed be the name of the Lord!'

At the beginning of 2023, we encountered space issues at the May Theatre. As the world came out of the pandemic, more people started returning to church. The 100 - seat room we worshipped in grew too small for us. That was when we began a campaign to raise funds and planned to acquire a building. We found a building in the downtown area of Lloydminster, which we prayed for, but by March, we realized that building wasn't for us.

Just as we began to seek and pray for guidance, we received news that the Vic Juba Community Theatre was open to partnering with us. In June we signed the agreement and to honor this new



and exciting partnership, Mosaic gave \$17,000 to help them upgrade their stage lighting. In July, Mosaic said good-bye to the May Theatre and we worshipped in our new space at the beginning of August.



Since then, our worship attendance has grown. What a huge blessing it is for us to have Lloydminster's premiere performing arts center as a worship space where we can declare God's praises, hear His Word and bring friends and family to discover Christ's love for them. The Vic provides both the space for growth and some time to raise funds for a future permanent home.

While a church building is important, the church is not a building, The church is God's redeemed people. God so graciously saved us and made us His children through Christ! As His children, our role in God's plan to redeem this world, as Apostle Paul profoundly puts it in 2 Corinthians (5:17-20), is to call people back to God.

Therefore, anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun! And all of this is a gift from God, who brought us back to himself through Christ. And God has given us this task of reconciling people to him. For God was in Christ, reconciling the world to himself, no longer counting people's sins against them. And he gave us this wonderful message of reconciliation. So we are Christ's ambassadors; God is making his appeal through us. We speak for Christ when we plead, "Come back to God!"

That is still why we exist as a church, and we shall remain true and faithful to that calling until Christ returns. Until then, let's invite the people of Lloydminster and this region to come back to God!





SPACE GOALS

- Continue partnership with the Vic Juba Theatre for 2025-2026.
- Hold two Sundays services when we reach 70% of the Vic Juba's capacity consistently (see below).
- Keep giving to our Building Fund, and launch a capital campaign in the New Year for possible future home.

- 650 active worship attendees by 2026.
- Start **12 new DGroups** and **24 leaders** in the next two years, with 60% of Mosaic attendees actively involved in DGroups/discipleship relationships and serving in teams.
- **200** Salvations Decisions and **100** Water Baptisms in the next two years.



OUR STORY / HIS STORY

In the New Testament book of Acts, we see story after story of how prayer played a significant role in the life of the early church. It was during a prayer meeting when 120 disciples gathered in a rented upper room of a house when God poured His promised Holy Spirit which led to the birth of the church. It was during a prayer meeting when the church sensed the need to send Paul and Silas to start plant churches throughout the Roman empire. And so it was that for us. It was at prayer meeting when Mosaic Lloydminster began.

On March 20th, 2014, Pastor Jon Las gathered a small group of 20 believers in a basement to pray and seek after God's will for them as a spiritual community. Together that small group of people envisioned to start a church that has the heart for reaching people who are far from God so they will be made alive and included in Christ.

Some Christians in the city told Pastor Jon to scrap the idea since there are more than enough number of churches. However, the caling was strong, and the group was unstoppable.

Mosaic had it's Connection Sunday on April 6th, 2014 at the Servus Sports Centre's OTS Room. Connection Sunday was initially meant as an interest and vision meeting, with the hope of launching the church by September, but God had something else in mind for the new church. With the Holy Spirit's leading, Connection Sunday became the official launch. The following Sunday, Mosaic gathered for worship, and by our third Sunday we were having two services!

Pastor Jon together with the Leadership Team: Richie Davies, Ambet David and Jayden Friesen, yielding to the Spirit of God planned to navigate the next steps of our journey. Pastor Ta joined the team in June, as the Associate Pastor.

Since then, over 700 people have given their lives to Christ through the ministry of Mosaic. We have also since partnered with two great church networks: the Canadian National Baptist Convention (CNBC) and the Association of Related Church (ARC), through which we are able to help start Spirit-filled, Bible-centered churches all across this nation and beyond.

Our story is part God's wider redemption story.




